BSA Scholarships*

This scholarship is a competitive scholarship to be awarded to students who meet the following criteria:

BIMS major with financial need as determined by Student Financial Aid

Cannot be a BSA officer on 2/1/2023

Completed 24 hours total coursework, at TAMU, in the Fall 2022/Spring 2023 semesters

U1 (continuing) or U2 (continuing) status on 2/1/2023

Minimum 3.0 overall TAMU GPA on 2/1/2023

Distinguished member of the Biomedical Sciences Association in the Fall 2022 and Spring 2023 semesters:

- 5 meetings attended

- 4 Social points

- 30 community service points (at least 12 points must be BSA affiliated)

- Distinguished active member form documenting all the above should be submitted for both Fall and Spring semesters

Students who receive a scholarship will be notified by email to the @email.tamu.edu email address, and the funds will be deposited into their student account for the Fall 2023 semester.

A block will remain on all recipients' accounts until a thank you letter is written to the Biomedical Sciences Association. The letter will be delivered to the current officer team and staff advisors.
